

Greater Chautauqua FCU Financial Summary as of 12/31/2022.

The Credit Union closed out the year with

- 9,570 in Total Members!
- \$83 million in Shares & Deposits!
- \$35 million in Loans!
- \$91 million in Assets!

- Earned \$4 million from Loans, Investments, and Fees
- Operating Expenses totaled approximately \$3.1 million
- \$42,000 was expensed out to cover Loan Losses
- GCFCU paid out \$296,821 to our members in Dividends

After all expenses and dividends were paid, our net income resulted in \$537,104.



The pie chart above shows the impact member borrowing has on the credit union's income. Loans account for 58% of our total income which is then returned to our members in the form of lower loan rates, dividends on savings, and outstanding products and services! The credit union continues to provide a safe, convenient place to save and borrow with competitive rates and personal service suited toward your specific needs.





SHARE INSURANCE COVERAGE OVERVIEW



How does the National Credit Union Administration (NCUA) protect my money?

The NCUA is the independent federal agency that administers the National Credit Union Share Insurance Fund. Credit unions that are federally insured by the NCUA offer a safe place for you to save your money, with deposits insured up to \$250,000 per individual depositor.



How do I know my money is 100% protected?

FIRST STEP: Know how your accounts are organized, based on type of ownership.

SECOND STEP: Divide your accounts into four ownership

categories:

1. INDIVIDUAL 2. JOINT

3. TRUST 4. RETIREMENT
