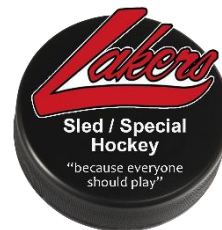


# Annual Lakers Sled/Special Hockey Program Fundraiser

## What are Sled and Special Hockey?

**Sled Hockey**, founded in 2003, is a unique program that was designed to give physically challenged individuals the ability to play Ice Hockey using specially designed sleds instead of traditional ice skates. The program has offered these individuals the opportunity to play an organized sport that otherwise would not be possible.

**Special Hockey**, founded in 2012, is a program designed for individuals with developmental disabilities to play hockey at their pace and skill level.

Both programs have offered individuals with disabilities more than a chance to play a sport. We have had the pleasure of watching their self-esteem grow along with their sense of pride and accomplishment. The smiles on the player's faces are PRICELESS!

The success of these programs is solely dependent on donations and sponsors like yourself. **Examples of yearly costs our Programs encounter are ice time (\$8,000-\$10,000), outfitting a player (\$450-\$500), providing a sled (\$700), plus repairs and upkeep of equipment.** Your generosity will continue to enrich the lives of these athletes and we are hoping we can count on you to support the Lakers Disabled Hockey Programs. **WITHOUT PEOPLE LIKE YOU, WE SIMPLY WOULDN'T EXIST.**
